1. *Flight* is written from the perspective of Jakob. Write one of the scenes from the perspective of Kizzy. Maybe when she first turns up or heals Raluca's leg or when she first learns to ride using the saddle.
2. Create a sensory/visual poem. The story takes the reader through all sorts of settings, which are often in the dark: the forests, by the river and up the mountain.
3. Write some diary entries from any one of the character's perspectives: Jakob, Kizzy or Herr Engel.
4. Write a newspaper article about the journey saving the horses or about the performance by the Spanish Riding School in front of General Patton.
5. Both General Patton and Director Podhajsky are real people. Research into them then create short biographies.
6. Write blog posts about Vienna as if travel agents and are convincing people to go on holiday there. (Cross curricula with Geography)
