



Flight Teaching Resources

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PSHE

1. Prejudice: Both Jakob and Kizzy are in fear for their lives because of who there are and the prejudice they've experienced. Flight can open discussions around these subjects.
2. Explore Gender Equality: There are times when Kizzy gets fed with Director Podhajsky because he doesn't let her do the same jobs as Jakob and they make her wear skirts.
3. Diversity: I am a disabled writer. I am on crutches because one of my legs doesn't work too well, but I also have an invisible disability – which means that it is not obvious when you look at me. I am fed by a tube into my stomach because I can't swallow properly. Extend this to consider diversity in books. Can they think of many disabled characters in books?
4. Animal welfare: Investigate whether animals during WWII were looked after properly.



5. Flight is all about working as a team: open discussions about how important it is to work as a team.
6. Flight has themes of loss, grief and family, showing that family is not always who you are born with.
