



How have humans adapted to live in this new world? Are there any difficulties that they now have to face? Who is your main character? What do they want? Is this different to what they need?




Top Writing Tip: Drip feed worldbuilding details throughout the story - don't tell us everything on the first page. Wait for each detail to come up naturally in the story.


